

Boolean results

- Any results or Boolean settings in calculations are written using FileMaker's support for **True** and **False** (not as literal string values such as 'True' and 'False') instead of using the values of zero (0) and (1). This increases readability of code.

<code>~missingParams = If (\$checkScriptName = True ; ~matching ~expected ; False)</code>	good
<code>~missingParams = If (\$checkScriptName = 1 ; ~matching ~expected ; 0)</code>	bad
